

Iowa Sheep Industry Association 2020 Scholarship

This is a one-time \$500.00 scholarship awarded to high school seniors who will be attending a two or four-year college.

Applicants must have an involvement and a passion for the sheep industry. The award is based on individual scholastic performance, leadership, citizenship and participation in sheep related activities.

The scholarship will be awarded directly to the recipient. Payment will be made after the recipient provides a completed first-semester college GPA transcript copy to the scholarship committee.

The recipient will be asked to work one day at the Iowa Sheep & Wool Festival, (June of 2020 with dates to be announced) and/or one shift at the Iowa State Fair Lamb Food Stand, and provide a newsletter article about themselves for publication in the Iowa Sheep Industry Association Newsletter. The recipient must attend a predetermined time, likely during the Iowa Sheep & Wool Festival, for the presentation of the award.

Instructions:

1. Complete Scholarship Application Form and Narrative.
2. Attach Two (2) non-family letters of recommendation, with contact information.
3. Provide a brief cover letter addressing "Why I am applying for this scholarship".
4. Attach a current GPA transcript.
