The course will be taught by lead-instructor Alex Moser, a professional sheep shearer from Lester, IA who is one of the best shearers in the USA!

This shearing school is possible because of funding from the lowa Sheep and Wool Promotion Board. While the cost of instruction is largely sponsored from the funding from ISWPB, there will be a \$100 fee per student to cover the cost of snacks, lunch, refreshments and additional instruction. Partial scholarships may be available. Students must be at least 16 years old to attend.
